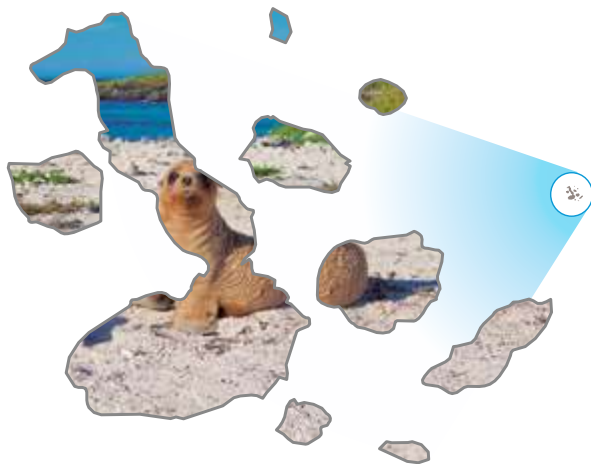


Oniric, an alternative form of Oneiric from the Greek “Oneirikos”, refers to a dreamlike event.

Welcome to Galapagos



Located 1000km / 600 miles from the mainland, the enchanting Galapagos Islands are easily Ecuador's greatest draw, famed worldwide for their high number of endemic wildlife species above and under the waves.

Formed by a series of volcanic eruptions, the archipelago evolved in complete isolation. Charles Darwin was the first person to discover in 1835 that the islands are a true living laboratory of evolution, which you can experience yourself until today. Due to a lack of major predators, wildlife is fearless, and animal encounters are unlike any other place on earth.

The Galapagos Marine Reserve offers the most extraordinary diving, by many considered among the best in the world. The confluence of three major oceanic currents allow encounters with giant whale sharks (june-november), schooling hammerheads, Galapagos sharks, great variety of rays, marine iguanas, big schools of salema, barracuda, snappers and groupers, mola mola (ocean sunfish), huge sea turtles, playful sea lions and much more astonishing marine life.

Pre/Post Daily Dive Extensions

Besides our Galapagos Liveboards and Naturalist cruises, we can also offer you daily dives from the islands of Santa Cruz and San Cristobal as well as any other travel arrangements required. Please find an overview of the main daily dive sites available and what could be seen.

Location	Description
Gordon Rocks	Schools of up to 50 hammerhead sharks, white and black tip reef sharks, green sea turtles, sea lions, sting rays, eagle rays, large schools of barracuda and snapper, occasionally manta ray or mola mola.
North Seymour	Many white and black tip reef sharks, hammerhead sharks, sea turtles. Large schools of barracuda, snapper and other reef fish, octopi, schools of spotted eagle rays, devil and manta rays.
Mosquera	Schools of eagle rays, hammerhead sharks, black tip reef sharks, Galapagos shark, Galapagos garden eel, manta rays.
Floreana	Large schools of black striped salema, red lipped batfish, white and black tipped reef sharks, green sea turtles, sting rays, eagle rays, and hammerheads, sea lions.
Beagle Rocks	Colorful reef fish, hammerheads and Galapagos sharks, rays, green sea turtles and sea lions, manta rays.
Guy Fawkes	Colourful fish, Red lipped Bat Fish, white tipped reef sharks, schools of black striped salema and rays, sea lions.
Daphne Minor	Manta rays, Galapagos sharks, white tipped reef sharks, eagle and marble rays.
Santa Fe	Sea lions, turtles, white tipped reef sharks, rays and large schools of fish.
Kicker Rock	Hammerheads, Galapagos sharks, black tip reef sharks, green sea turtles, sea lions, eagle rays, large schools of barracuda, black striped salema and tuna, occasionally manta ray or mola mola.





Guayaquil & Diving from the Pacific Coast

The city of Guayaquil, known as the Pearl of the Pacific, is Ecuador's biggest city and one of the international airports of arrival and departure. Explore the Ecuadorian Coast, offering a hidden dive site where manta rays get really up close, or discover the lowlands full of plantations of bananas, cocoa beans and tropical fruits.





— Quito & Andean Region

Quito is the capital city of Ecuador, close to the Equator line, holding one of the most precious historical centers of Latin America. The surrounding Andean highlands offer plenty of diversity, such as snow-capped volcanoes, crater lakes, indigenous markets, Andean cultures & flavors, lush and abundant cloud forests or relaxing hot springs.





Amazon Region

More than one third of Ecuador's surface is covered by the Amazon basin. During the last ice age this area served as a refuge and converted into a hotspot of biodiversity. Discover some of the best wildlife in the Amazon and its local cultures at just a short distance of Quito. Lodges, river cruises or even further off-the-beaten path
